Call to order: Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, Mayor Danelski called the Special City Council Meeting at 6:00 pm.

Recommendations for the Employment Interview Committee

The mayor began the discussion by sharing with the council that only one applicant applied for the position. The job posting had run in the Moose Lake Gazette, the North Pine County News and Evergreen newspapers. The council members reviewed Larry Coursolle's application. Previously, K. Philipps had met with Larry Coursolle on Friday, August 19, 2022, for the initial candidate interview. At that time Larry had given a description of his work history. He was asked questions by K. Philipps. Council member K. Phillipps suggested a full council interview be scheduled prior to hiring. Today Larry again was asked questions by the council members present and answered them to the satisfaction of the council. The interview was also recorded and is on file with the city clerk. The job description was described to Larry, which he understands and that the hours will be up to 30 hours a week during the summer months and down to 20 hours a week during the winter months. A full list of work will be provided to Larry on his first day and he will be able to prioritize it with the council. First day will be Monday, August 29, 2022, at 10:00 am.

K. Grey made a motion to hire Larry Coursolle as Public Works Superintendent at \$18.00 per hour, seconded by D. Lingle. Motion carried with a roll-call vote with all members present voting in favor.


Adjournment
